Thank you for your interest in becoming a member of FLAGS. The application process is really quite simple. Please follow the steps below and we look forward to welcoming you as a Unit Member in due course.

If you have a current CRB Disclosure for England & Wales within The Scout Association, which is dated within 5 years, then you need to complete the Change of Role form (Form CR) to add FLAGS as additional role.

If you are a member of The Scout Association with a Disclosure from Access NI or Disclosure Scotland, or if you are not a member of The Scout Association then you will need to complete the Adult Application form (Form AA). This form includes getting your ID checked by a local member of Scouting or other non-related person so that a CRB Disclosure can be obtained for you.

When completing either Form CR or Form AA, you need to fill in the following:

Your role is: District Scout Active Support Member
District: FLAGS
County: National Headquarters

If you are completing Form CR, please select 'Additional Role', this will not affect any other roles you currently have in Scouting.

The Membership Fee is £10 per year with a student rate of £5. If you are a full-time student, please send a scan of your NUS card or other proof of status with your application. Our preferred method of payment is to make a bank transfer of £10 or £5 (as appropriate) to our bank account which is detailed below:
